We are glad that we made the decision to fly back to the U.S. this time as violence continues to escalate especially in the city where we cross, Nuevo Laredo. We would drive through both Nuevo Laredo and Monterrey on our trip to Mexico City.

Presidential elections will be held in July. A liberal candidate Peña Nieto is expected to win over the conservative and socialist candidates. Some say that the drug violence will slow
